RESOLUTION NO. 21-R-25

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE MILLAGE RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2021, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2022, AS 4.1000 MILLS FOR THE CITY OF TALLAHASSEE AND 1.0000 MILL FOR THE DOWNTOWN IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY, WHICH IS GREATER THAN THE AGGREGATE ROLLED-BACK RATE OF 3.9867 BY 3.30% AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS the City of Tallahassee is required by Florida law to publicly state the millage rate to be levied for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021, and ending September 30, 2022; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Tallahassee is required to state the percentage by which the millage rate is greater than the rolled-back rate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That the millage rate established for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021, and ending September 30, 2022, is 4.1000 mills for the City of Tallahassee and 1.0000 mill for the Downtown Improvement Authority, which is greater than the aggregate rolled-back rate of 3.9867 mills by 3.30%.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective October 1, 2021.

Section 3. The title of this Resolution was read during the public hearing at the meeting of the City Commission of the City of Tallahassee on the 22nd day of September 2021.
